CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Thomas C. Ballew, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 36, T.26N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 36 bears N. 48° 20' 25" E., a distance of 2,039.22 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Denny and Della Mulford

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 7, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, 400 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Franklin electric motor and Gould submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed via ± 200 feet of 3/4" pipeline to one 500 gallon trough and one 250 gallon trough, where 500 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NE¼ Section 36, T.26N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
