CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 5 (NE¼ SW¼) Section 23, T.23N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 23 bears N. 89° 31' 27" E., a distance of 2,915.72 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.013 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	May 11, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 130 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Grundfos submersible pump and 3/4 H.P. motor powered by a 2,250 watt generator, to three 800 gallon circular watering troughs 6 feet in diameter, where 400 head of cattle water within all of Sections 14, 23, and 26 all in T.23N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M. (Manhattan Allotment).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
