CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Joseph Glen Kircher, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cedar Hill Canyon Spring through a diversion box, storage tank and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 20, T.17N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 20 bears N. 60° 41' E., a distance of 1,952.0 feet situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joseph Glen Kircher

Source: Cedar Hill Canyon Spring

Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 6, 1989

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

1.0 acre within the NE¼ NE¼ Section 20, T.17N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annua from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
