CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Conn Davis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 2 Section 33, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 33 bears S. 40° 32' 22" E., a distance of 2,483.81 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Koch Sulfur Products Company

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial

Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.334 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 20, 1992


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 260 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch casing, via a 1½ H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to a transfer station consisting of offices, equipment wash and emergency showers located within Lot 1 and Lot 2, Section 33, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
