CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Vahid Behmaram, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 23, T.21N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 23 bears S. 50° 17' 03" E., a distance of 2488.19 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Washoe County

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Recreation and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s, but not to exceed 0.465 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 23, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 205 feet deep, 6 inch diameter steel casing, equipped with a 2 horsepower submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed to two 85 gallon pressure tanks to serve Horsemans Park in Lemmon Valley for recreational and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
