CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 22, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 22 bears S. 87° 12' E., a distance of 2,100.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: G. J. Iratcabal
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *June 22, 1960

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 8" diameter casing, equipped with a 7½ H.P. 3 phase motor and Goulds pump used to water 100 head of cattle within a portion of the SE¼ of Section 22, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 18959, Certificate 5871, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18959, Certificate 5871.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
