CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Dorothy Kelnhofer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 20, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 20 bears N. 46° 11' 40" W., a distance of 1757.61 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John I. Harrison
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Commercial
Amount of appropriation: 0.0268 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.37 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 21, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 180 feet deep, 12 inch casing, via a 1½ H.P. submersible pump thence through a distribution system to an RV park (Chipmunk Retreat) with 20 hookups with landscaping located within the E¼ SE¼ NW¼ NE¼ Section 20, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M. for commercial purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
