CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Marc Granat, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 19 bears N. 84° 32' 40" W., a distance of 2025.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Granat Revocable Family Trust of 10-18-85 and Robert Alan and Susan Anding Moore

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.089 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.83 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 8, 1985

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 240 feet deep, 8 inch casing via a 1 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to a nursery, retail office with a bathroom and landscaping located within the NE¼ NW¼ Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
