CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a spring box and pipeline for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 8, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 17, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 18° 22' 44" E., a distance of 8126.33 feet situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Basalite

Source: An Unnamed Spring

Manner of Use: Mining and Milling

Amount of appropriation: *0.02 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.26 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 19, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a spring box, thence through approximately 2,300 feet down a natural channel where it is impounded in a settlement pond measuring approximately 36' long x 15' x 3' deep with a capacity of approximately 10,000 gallons with an 18' long x 3' high dam at the pond's lower end. Two 1 inch PVC pipes lead from the dam to a filter hut where debris is removed from the water. The water is then conveyed another 4,430 feet by two buried 1 inch PVC pipes to a meter box where it is metered and then conveyed to six storage tanks for dust abatement and to a shop, crusher and fire hydrant. The place of use is described as being the SE¼ Section 8; S½ SW¼ Section 9; NW¼ NE¼, E½ E½, Section 17, NW¼, W½ NE¼, N½ S½, Section 16; all within T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty and diversion rate of water under Permits 55473, 56460, 56461, 56462, 56463, 56464 and 56465 shall not exceed 40.0 acre-feet annually and 0.125 c.f.s., respectively.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
