CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert H. Cantley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 16, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 16 bears S. 74° 58' 06" E., a distance of 1859.98 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bing Construction Company

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Industrial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: *0.029 c.f.s., but not to exceed 21.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: **March 19, 1957

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 185 feet deep, 12 inch casing via a 50 H.P. Johnson pump, thence through a distribution system to a sand and gravel plant operation located within the S¼ NW¼ SW¼ and SW¼ SW¼ Section 16, and the E¼ SE¼ SE¼ Section 17, and the N¼ NW¼ NW¼ Section 21, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 24427 Certificate 7330, Permit 53265 Certificate 14147, Permit 53267 Certificate 14148 and any certificate issued under Permit 53266 shall not exceed 854.74 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Permit 22224, Certificate 5983, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 17214, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17214.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
