CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, George W. Gillemot, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 2, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2 bears S. 69° 30' 51" W., a distance of 687.75 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George W. Gillemot Family Trust

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: \*0.0095 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.5225 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*\*November 30, 1959

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 480 feet deep, 6 3/4 inch casing, via a 15 H.P. pump, thence through a distribution system including a 100,000 gallon tank to one home, a caretakers cabin, a tennis club house and landscaping for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the SW¼ SW¼ Section 2, SE¼ SE¼ Section 3, NE¼ NE¼ Section 10 and NW¼ NW¼ Section 11, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and any certificates issued under Permits 55837 and 58263 shall not exceed 3.451 million gallons annually.

\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 18448, Certificate 6239, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18448, Certificate 6239.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.
