CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Stimpson Spring through a pipeline and troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 22, T.26N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 22 bears N. 4°29'48" E., a distance of 2269.68 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Denny S. and Della C. Mulford
Source: Stimpson Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.013 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 21, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through 100 1/2 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to two troughs, one trough being 10 feet long, 3 feet wide and 1 1/2 feet deep and the other trough being 8 feet long, 3 feet wide and 1 1/2 feet deep where 400 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, T.26N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
