CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fred Salisbury, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from White Fire Spring, through perforated pipe, a catch basin and distribution system for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 25, T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N¹/₄ corner of Section 23, T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 41°25'49" W., a distance of 8,219.8 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	White Fire Spring
Manner of use:	Mining and Milling
Amount of appropriation:	0.50 c.f.s. but not to exceed 43.69 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*January 24, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from White Fire Spring by means of a 4-inch diameter PVC perforated pipe to a 5-foot diameter by 6-foot deep catch basin, thence through 2,500 feet of 4-inch diameter PVC pipe, thence through an additional 2,000 feet of 8-inch diameter PVC pipe to the place of use for mining and milling purposes located within the SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, W¹/₂ NE¹/₄, SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ and N¹/₂ SE¹/₄ Section 23 and the S¹/₂ NW¹/₄, SW¹/₄, NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ and SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 24, T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B. & M.



Water is diverted from White Fire Spring by means of a 4 inch diameter PVC perforated pipe to a 5 foot diameter by 6 foot deep catch basin thence through 2500 feet of 4 inch PVC pipe thence through an additional 2,000 feet of 8 inch PVC pipe to the place of use for mining and milling purposes within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.


