CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ronald W. Turner, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through an intake line, pumping station and ditribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NE corner of said
Section 27, bears N. 78°20'33" E., a distance
of 2967.4 feet situated in Douglas County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Elk Trust
Source: Lake Tahoe
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.0046 c.f.s., but not to exceed
3.36 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
year
Date of priority of
appropriation: **Prior to 1870

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a submerged inlet structure with 120 feet of 8" O.D., P.E. fusion line; a water booster pumping station with 3 pumps being an Aurora 5 HP, 30 GPM, an Aurora 15 HP 75 GPM and an Aurora 30 HP 500 GPM; and McCrometer, Model No. MW-500 totalizing meter. This system serves one main home, a guest house, a caretaker's house and landscaping situated on 11.52 acres \pm within portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., being APN Nos. 03-050-01 and 03-070-02.


*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 45354 which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Proof 01768 Certificate 337 of the McFaul Creek Decree, October 6, 1942, in the First Judicial District Court, State of Nevada., therefore the date of priority remains the same as decreed.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
