CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the West Side Spring, also known as Tub Spring, through pipeline to troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 36, T.39N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 20, T.39N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 45°44'W., a distance of 21,404.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: N.J. Ranches
Source: West Side Spring, also known as Tub Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0111 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 24, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted by means of a 3 foot corrugated metal pipe spring box with a 1½ inch outlet pipe to two 3 foot 3 inch wide by 14 foot long by 1 foot deep troughs where 500 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SW¼ Section 36, T.39N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3747 dated October 11, 1990.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
