CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Thomas A. Foote, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for Industrial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T.19N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
or at a point from which the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of
said Section 22 bears N.20°18'W., a distance
of 4963.0 feet situated in Storey County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Refuse, Inc.
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Industrial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	.056 c.f.s., but not to exceed *5.0 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**December 22, 1977

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 507 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch diameter steel casing, equipped with a 10 horsepower submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed through a meter to two 20,000 gallon storage tanks. The water is used for dust control at the Lockwood Regional Landfill located within portions of Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, T.19N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty and rate of diversion under this certificate and any certificates issued under Permit 55706 shall not exceed 40.0 million gallons annually and 0.31 cubic feet per second, respectively.


**This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Permit 50463, which changed the place of use of Permit 38767, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 34754, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 34754.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
