CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Ronald Brandt, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 29, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 29 bears N.04°19'31"W., a distance of 1029.81 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ronald Brandt
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Commercial
Amount of appropriation: 0.0009 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.038 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 5, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 32 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch casing, via a Grundfos submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to Smith's Equipment & Welding Shop for Commercial purposes located within a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 29 T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
