CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Don L. Ellifritz, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 26, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the C¼ corner of said Section 26 bears N.02°45'00"W., a distance of 877.80 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Don L. & Mary Lou Ellifritz
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.00619 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.46 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 13, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to four residential mobile homes on parcels APN 10-061-26, 10-061-41, 10-061-42 and 10-061-43 located within the S¼ of Section 26, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 22800 Certificate 7400 shall not exceed 34.8 acre-feet annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
