CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William J. Kirker and Avis L. Kirker, Permittees have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 10, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 10 bears N.13°37'W., a distance of 848.9 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William J. Kirker and Avis L. Kirker
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation
Amount of appropriation: 0.24 c.f.s., but not to exceed 25.0 acre feet annually.
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *June 09, 1969

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

5 acres in the N¼ SE¼ NW¼ SW¼ of Section 10, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 25099 Certificate 10306, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25099 Certificate 10306.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
