CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Ben F. Collins, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, storage tank and distribution system for Recreation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 12, T.21S., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 12 bears S. 82°02' E., a distance of 1,227.74 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Recreation & Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0014 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.318 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 14, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 503 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a submersible pump to a 10,900 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to the Red Rock Visitor Center located within the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 12, T.21S., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
