CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Alfred J. Thompson III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from and underground source through a drilled well, pump and a drip irrigation system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T.17N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 24 bears S. 25°45'31" E., a distance of 1,848.25 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Emma Thomsen Holler
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation
Amount of appropriation: 0.0083 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: \*June 16, 1972

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.5 acres located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T.17N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 26778 Certificate 9347, therefore, the priority date remains the same as Permit 26778 Certificate 9347.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
