CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Donald J. Tippin, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from and underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 24 bears N. 28°25'08" W., a distance of 1,886.67 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Boat World, Inc.
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Commercial
Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.75 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 21, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a drilled well, 41 feet deep, 6 inch diameter steel casing, equipped with a 3/4 horsepower submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed through a meter to a commercial building. The water is used for restrooms and washing vehicles and boats within a portion of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
