CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a spring, through a spring box and pipeline to a trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 36, T.30N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36 bears S. 42°03'00" E., a distance of 2,500.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Elko Blacksmith Shop, Inc.
Source: Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 5, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted through a 2 foot culvert spring box and 300± feet of 1 inch pipeline to a 10 foot diameter round trough where 250 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 36, T.30N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, and is further subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3759 dated December 17, 1990.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
