CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Karl U. Bedke, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well with a submersible pump to a trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Government Lot 4, Section 5, T.46N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Lot 4 bears N.26°09'20"W., a distance of 458.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bedke's K-Savy Ranch, Inc.
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use: April 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 5, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well having a 6 5/8 inch casing to 306 feet, equipped with a 2 H.P. submersible Grundfos pump, thence to a trough where 1,000 head of cattle water within Sections 5 and 8, T.46N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. and Section 31, T.47N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., located within the Big Bend allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
