CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well and pipeline to an earthen pond for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.37N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the SW corner of said
Section 30 bears S.21°54'25"W., a distance of
1,829.04 feet situated in Humboldt County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	DeLong Ranches, Inc.
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0446 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**November 29, 1982

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a 16 inch cased well being 345 feet deep and equipped with a Newman motor and National pump, thence through 400 feet of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipeline to an earthen pond where 400 head of cattle water within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. T.37N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M.

The point of diversion is located on public land located within the Jackson Mountain allotment, while the place of use is located on private land.


*The total combined duty under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permits 56342 and 56343 shall not exceed the amount of water that is sufficient to water 400 head of cattle.

**This certificate changes the manner of use and place of use of a portion of Permit 46397, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 46397.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
