CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, David A. Donnelly, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 73) (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T20S., R.50E., M.D.B.44.
or at a point from which the NW corner of said
Section 23 bears N.79°24'05"W., a distance of
709.89 feet situated in Clark County, State of
Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Las Vegas Valley Water District
Source:	Underground (Well No. 73) (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)
Manner of Use:	Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*0.862 c.f.s. but not to exceed 631.78 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**March 1, 1945

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is developed by means of a drilled well, 1,034 feet deep, 20 inch casing, via a deep well pump equipped with a 700 H.P. electric motor to pipelines and reservoirs, thence through a distribution system to the area included within the boundaries of the Las Vegas Valley Water District as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended for municipal and domestic purposes.


*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permits 53919 and 55888 shall not exceed 1.582 c.f.s. and 1,153.122 acre-feet annually, respectively.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 36111 Certificate 11034, which changed the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of Permit 11249 Certificate 3092, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11249 Certificate 3092.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
