CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Tom Glab, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T.35N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 22 bears N. 75°17'58" E., a distance of 814.27 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada, Department of Prisons

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.602 c.f.s., but not to exceed 9.04 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: May 15, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 10 inch casing, via a 15 H.P. submersible pump and 3 booster pumps to a 165,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to the Humboldt Conservation Camp located within portions of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22, T.35N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
