## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Erik Beyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through an infiltration galley and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 13, T.35N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.,  
or at a point from which the NE corner of said  
Section 13 bears N. 82°24' E., a distance of  
1,017.0 feet situated in Humboldt County,  
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Golconda General Improvement District
Source:	Unnamed Spring
Manner of Use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.235 million gallons annually
Period of use:	September 16th to March 14th of the next year
Date of priority of appropriation:	January 15, 1986

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unnamed spring by means of an infiltration galley, a 10 foot manhole with 6 inch overflow pipe to Pole Creek, via a 4 inch transmission main, thence through a distribution system to the Town of Golconda located within the E $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32 and W $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.36N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. and further described as within the boundary of the Golconda General Improvement District.

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 55543 shall not exceed 8.82 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issued specifically subject to Claim of Vested Right 01579 in the name of Central Pacific Railroad and the water under this certificate is that over and above the amount in said claim.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
