CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gary Bengochea, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of said Section 19, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 54°21' W., a distance of 11,240.00 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Manner of Use: Irrigation
 Amount of appropriation: *0.83 c.f.s., but not to exceed *488.00 acre-feet annually
 Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

*The total combined rate of diversion under this Certificate and Permit 34816 Certificate 9513 shall not exceed 3.28 c.f.s.


*The total combined duty of water under this Certificate and Permit 34815 Certificate 9512 shall not exceed 488.0 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 34815 Certificate 9512, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 30064, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 29252, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 27506, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26015, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26015.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
