CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, H.E. Loufek, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Louse Town Creek through a dam, pump and pipeline for Mining and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.18N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NE corner of said
Section 21 bears N. 20°30' E., a distance of
2,035.0 feet situated in Storey County, State
of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Castle Peak Quicksilver Company
Source:	Louse Town Creek
Manner of Use:	Mining and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.025 c.f.s., but not to exceed 6.03 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	June 9, 1928


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of 1,200 feet of 2 inch drain pipe to dam and sump, thence through a gasoline powered pumping plant through 5,880 feet of 2 inch pipe to the place of use for Mining and Domestic purposes located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T.18N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
