CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Abe Dayani, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Industrial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T.18S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 34 bears S. 30°55'25" W., a distance of 4,223.71 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Georgia Pacific Corporation

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Industrial

Amount of appropriation: 0.350 c.f.s., but not to exceed 46.97 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *October 28, 1986

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 1,200 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 60 H.P. Reda submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to a manufacturing plant and support facilities for Industrial purposes located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34; and NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35 T.18S., R63E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 50316, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 50316.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
