CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gary Crocker, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underdrain through a collection box, pipeline and storage tank for irrigation (landscaping) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 33, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 55° 52' 00" E., a distance of 1,225.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Gary Crocker
 Source: Underdrain
 Manner of Use: Irrigation (Landscaping)
 Amount of appropriation: *0.0223 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually
 Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation: February 27, 1991

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.50 acres in the SE¼ SE¼ of Section 33, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate is totally supplemental to Permit 55891. The total combined duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 55891 shall not exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
