**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, Carl Ruschmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through an intake line, pumps, storage tank and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, T.14N., R.18E., N.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 15 bears N. 84°35' E., a distance of 3,770.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Douglas County
Source:	Lake Tahoe
Manner of Use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0059 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.1625 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**January 21, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of the Uppaway pump station on Lake Tahoe, through a 600 foot intake line, via two 20 H.P. pumps to a 133,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to serve Lot 15 of the Uppaway Subdivision, Douglas County Assessors Parcel No. 01-100-15 located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, T.14N., R.18E., N.D.B.&M.


\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 29160, Certificate 9714; Permit 31076, Certificate 9716; and any certificates issued under Permits 54376, 56648, 56649, 56780, and 62107 shall not exceed 7.118 million gallons annually.

\*\*This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 31076 Certificate 9716 which changed the manner of use of a portion of Permit 29160, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29160.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
