CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Russell D. Highfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground source (Well #1) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Recreation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Tract 43) Section 15, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 15 bears N. 28° W., a distance of 650.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Well #1)
Manner of Use:	Recreation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.086 c.f.s., but not to exceed 16.521 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each Year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*January 11, 1980

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 660 feet deep, 8 inch casing via a 3 H.P. submersible pump to a 30,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution to Ski Lee for snowmaking and to a 7,500 gallon concrete storage tank which serves the Clark County Youth Camp and to three 10,000 gallon storage tanks which serve the Forest Service Campgrounds for Recreational and Domestic purposes located within portions of Sections 2, 3, 10, and 15 and Tracts 43, 52, 53, and 54 all in T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 40286, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 40286.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
