CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from China Garden Spring No. 1 through a culvert and pipeline to a pond for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE½ SE½ Section 7, T.38N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.,
 or at a point from which the NW corner of said
 Section 7 bears N. 58°27' W., a distance of
 4,929.0 feet situated in Humboldt County,
 State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Manner of Use: Stockwater
 Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water
 500 head of cattle
 Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
 year
 Date of priority of
 appropriation: September 24, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted through a 21 inch culvert pipe installed
 in the spring, thence through a 1 inch pipeline to an 11
 , 12 feet long and 2 feet deep pond where 500 head of
 water within the NE½ SE½ Section 7, T.38N., R.38E.,

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount
 to be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above
 and the use is restricted to the place and for the
 purposes set forth herein.
