CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Polar Star Spring through pipeline to a trough and cistern for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T.33N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 23 bears S. 15°55' E., a distance of 1,830.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Loyd Sorensen

Source: Polar Star Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.014 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 14, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from an improved spring through 100 feet of buried 1 1/2 inch pipeline to a trough, thence through 100 feet of overflow pipe to a cement cistern where 300 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23, T.33N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3675 dated January 23, 1990.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
