CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Barbara Worth Spring through a spring box and pipeline to two troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 7, T.36N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 7 bears N. 33°33' W., a distance of 2,598.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: DeLong Ranches, Inc.

Source: Barbara Worth Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 10, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from Barbara Worth Spring via a spring box, thence through 1.6 miles of 1 1/4 inch pipeline to two 16 feet by 4 feet by 4 feet troughs where 200 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, T.36N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. and Lot 2 of Section 7, T.36N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
