CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a Cluster of Springs through a spring box and pipeline to a trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26, T.39N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 26 bears N. 70°13'00" E., a distance of 1,300.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Glaser Land and Livestock Co.

Source: Cluster of Springs

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 7, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a Cluster of Springs through a spring box, 3 inches in diameter and 4 feet deep, thence through 100± feet of 1 1/4 inch pipeline to a 20 feet long, 3 1/2 feet wide and 3 feet deep trough where 250 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, T.39N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
