CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, David G. Barneby, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Effluent (Clark County Sanitation District) through pipelines and reservoirs for Industrial (cooling) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T.21S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NW corner of said
Section 22 bears N. 47°14'48" W., a distance
of 1,061.84 feet situated in Clark County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Nevada Power Company
Source:	Effluent (Clark County Sanitation District)
Manner of Use:	Industrial (cooling)
Amount of appropriation:	0.912 c.f.s., but not to exceed 660.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*December 3, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Effluent is diverted by means of a 14 inch and 18 inch Transite pipeline from Clark County Sewer Farm to a 24.5 acre-foot reservoir at Clark Station and through a 20 inch pipeline to a 21.5 acre-foot reservoir at Sunrise Station for Industrial (power generation cooling) purposes located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 and a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T.21S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. (Clark Station) and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T.21S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. (Sunrise Station).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms and conditions of the agreement dated October 12, 1989 between Nevada Power Company and Clark County Sanitation District.

*The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of May 3, 1994.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
