CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Frank C. Hulse, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.4S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NW corner of said
Section 33 bears N. 50° 07' 21" W., a distance
of 2,268.36 feet situated in Lincoln County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.25 c.f.s., but not to exceed 95.44 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*April 8, 1985

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

19.70 acres in the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 33, T.4S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.
5.90 acres in the SW¼ NW¼ of Section 33, T.4S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.
25.60 Acres Total

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 48972, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 48972.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
