CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Brian A. Randall, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Effluent through pipelines, wastewater treatment plant, and a sprinkler system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.14N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 24 bears N. 56°48'27" E., a distance of 2,298.27 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.55 c.f.s., but not to exceed 17.75 acre-feet per annum
Period of use:	March 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	July 12, 1989

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

4.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T.14N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
