CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, windmill, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.33N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 24, T.33N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 52°28'50" E., a distance of 9,709.59 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Alan W. and Patricia Sharp
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 23, 1990


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 60 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a windmill to one trough 12 feet by 3 feet by 2 feet deep, where 300 head of cattle water within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T.33N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
