CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Starvation Well) through a drilled well, pump, and pipeline to a trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 31, T.32N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears S. 21°12'48" W., a distance of 5,710.46 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Julian Tomera Ranches, Inc., Stonehouse Division
Source: Underground (Starvation Well)
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 16, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 460 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a 1.5 H.P. Jacuzzi submersible pump and electric motor, thence through 660 feet of 1¼ inch pipeline to a 3,000 gallon trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NE¼ NW¼, Section 31, T.32N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
