CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Lee Windmill) through a drilled well, windmill, and pipe, to a trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T.37N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 5, T.36N., R34E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 12°18' W., a distance of 10,610.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: DeLong Ranches, Inc.
Source: Underground (Lee Windmill)
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 10, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled and cased 8 inch well of unknown depth, and a windmill. Thence through a 2 inch pipe into a cement bottom trough which has a diameter of 22 feet and a depth of 2 feet, where 200 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, T.37N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., in the Blue Mountain Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
