## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and stock troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 14, T.26N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M.,  
or at a point from which the SE corner of  
Section 24, T.26N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., bears  
S. 42°03'27" E., a distance of 8,329.81 feet  
situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: Underground  
Manner of Use: Stockwater  
Amount of appropriation: \*0.0125 c.f.s., or sufficient to  
water 400 head of cattle  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st  
of each year  
Date of priority of  
appropriation: September 10, 1992

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 120 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a 3/4 H.P. Jacuzzi submersible pump or windmill, thence to five troughs, one circular trough 12 feet in diameter, two 8 feet long by 4 feet wide by 3 feet deep and two 6 feet long by 2 feet wide and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet deep troughs, where 400 head of cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14 and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, T.26N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., in the J.D. Allotment.

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 52465, Certificate 14143, and any certificate issued under Permit 58059 shall not exceed that sufficient to water 600 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
