CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Donald V. Rogers, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution sytem for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 34, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 34 bears N. 53°29' W., a distance of 981.4 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Donald V. and Carolyn A. Rogers
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.471 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 19, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 67 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a ½ H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump and motor, thence through a distribution system to two residences located within the N¼ N¼ SW¼ Section 34, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
