CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 4 bears S. 88°59'42" E., a distance of 1,404.6 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Willomonte Land and Livestock
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.4066 c.f.s., but not to exceed 283.12 acre feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *May 6, 1977

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

1.09 acres in the NW¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
38.47 acres in the NE¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
2.35 acres in the SW¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
28.87 acres in the S¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
70.78 acres total issued supplemental to Truckee River Decreed Rights.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 52420, Certificate 14541, Permit 52421, Certificate 14542, Permit 52422, Certificate 14543, and any other certificates issued under Permits 52421 or 52450, shall not exceed 592.4 acre feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 49615 which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 31502, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 31502.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.5 acre feet per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
