CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. Randall Swan, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 3, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 3 bears N. 13°43'21" W., a distance of 435.83 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: H. Randall Swan & Cheryl K. Swan
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.365 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *March 23, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 90 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 1 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to one (1) house, located on APN 47-181-05 in the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 3, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., for quasi-municipal domestic purposes.

*The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of January 28, 1993.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
