CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Quinn Canyon Springs through a steel tank, pipeline, and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, T.1N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 5 bears N. 17°31'00" W., a distance of 2,359.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: Quinn Canyon Springs  
Manner of Use: Stockwater  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: \*September 20, 1909

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by excavation of a spring area and placement of a 6 feet diameter, 10 feet high, steel tank into ground on top of gravel bed. \*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 1433, Certificate 105. Therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 1433, Certificate 105.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

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The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
