CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James T. Anspach, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 14 bears S. 61°09'33" W., a distance of 1,470.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Denny McLarry, Trustee,
McLarry Family Trust

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: *0.006 c.f.s., but not exceed
4.335 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st
of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: **November 1, 1940

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 700 feet deep, 8 5/8 inch casing, via a 20 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to one major residence, a second residence, bunkhouse, barn and two work shops for quasi-municipal purposes located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 46072, Certificate 13233, and Permit 46073, Certificate 12351 and any certificate issued under Permit 62832 is limited to 13.68 million gallons annually.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 51984, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 46074, which changed the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of Permit 26693, Certificate 9160, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 10579, Certificate 2931, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 10579, Certificate 2931.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
